

# Annual Function 2019





What Dr. Hemant shah Said :

### From the Previous Profiles :

*“ Today, when I look back, over the period I see a big change – both in values and in outlook. With the changing values the emphasis have also been shifted and so are the activities. Students have become more friendly with the technology and have become less serious about reading and writing. Even then, at least, at Prakash still students have regard for elders, love for cleanliness and a high sense of responsibility moulding them into a disciplined future citizen of India. I’m amazed at their creativity and capacity to face the situation. It is this rosy picture that provides us with great inspiration to go ahead.”*

“ To respected parents, I would like to express on two – three issues. First, let us all understand that Education can not be a political or social agenda. Education is not a programme of a business meeting or discussion (mostly meaningless) of controversial issues. Education is a purposeful activity preparing every individual to be able to recognize his or her potentials with which he or she has to manifest the higher state of life. Education thus becomes a National Spiritual agenda. Two, we , through our Prayer – Meetings and through thought provoking ideas and quotations, want our students to be clear (away from delusions & myths) about our culture, tradition and religion: about faith, reason and knowledge, about freedom, happiness and effective citizenship; about the value of hard work, pain and suffering– all these leading them into learning to live with a positive approach, with love and joy. In this regard neither I am underestimating the students nor I am skeptic about your support and co-operation. Third, – I read somewhere a counselor writing by way of advice to the parents – I quote: “When parents strive to give their children the best of everything at an early age, they are sowing seeds for materially insatiable monster that are prone to sloth, apathy, avarice and fear. ... As I sit in my counselor's chair, day after day, I encounter an altogether a new disorder that I have come to label as – Parent Induced Wastefulness (PIW)....
